1. When is the Golf Tournament?
 - Saturday, July 16th
 - Prior registration required. Shuttle, breakfast, lunch provided for golfers
 - NEW: Golf awards will be presented during the Monday Banquet Dinner
2. When is the QA Meeting? Is separate registration required for attendance?

 - Sunday, 8:30 am - 3:00 pm
 - Separate registration is required.
3. Is there an event on Sunday night?
 - There is a welcome reception. Drinks and light food will be served.
 - Attire: Business Casual (no jacket required)
 - The welcome reception starts at 5:30 pm.
 - There is a restaurant at the Marriott and several within walking distance of the hotel.
4. What time does the meeting begin on Monday?
 - There is continental breakfast beginning at 7:00 am in the exhibit area.
 - General Session begins at 8:00 am.
 - Workshops begin at 1:30 pm on Monday and begin at 10:30 am on Tuesday.
5. Is there an event on Monday night?
 - Attire: Business (jacket recommended)
 - There is a Cocktail Reception followed by the Banquet Dinner.
 - NEW: Cocktail Reception will run from 6:00 pm – 7:00 pm
 - The dinner starts at 7:00 pm and will conclude by 8:30 pm
 - NEW: Golf Awards will be presented during the Banquet Dinner.
 - The presentation of the 2011 Edward J. Glueckler recipient will take place towards the end of the dinner.
 - NEW: There will be no post-dinner entertainment. Enjoy an evening on the town!
6. How do I get a copy of the presentations?
 - It is easy; all presentation will be uploaded to the ASA website. The website address is conveniently printed on the back of your name tag. If a presentation is missing, that means the speaker has not yet given it to ASA.
 - Paper copies of workshop presentations will be provided in all workshop rooms.
7. What is on the USB?

8. Can I attend both the ASA and AFRA meetings?

- Except for the ASA Member Breakfast (Tuesday morning) and the AFRA Member Meeting (Tuesday afternoon) all meetings are open to all attendees. Member meetings are limited to members of ASA or AFRA respectively.

9. When does the conference end?

- ASA's last meeting is the afternoon workshops on Tuesday.
- AFRA has a members meeting Tuesday afternoon and a full-day of meetings on Wednesday.

10. Will I get a training certificate?

- Training certificates will be mailed immediately following the meeting. In order to get credit for the workshops, make sure you sign-in on the workshop roster.

11. What is the dress code?

- Business casual for all meetings except a jacket is recommended for Monday night's dinner.
- Remember while it is hot outside, the meeting rooms will be cold.

12. What should I do while in DC?

- There are several things to do while in the District. Please ask the concierge for things to do and visit Washington.org for things to do and a calendar of events taking place throughout the city.
- National Mall, Smithsonian, Monuments are within walking distance of the hotel. Just turn left when you step out of the front door and walk down towards Pennsylvania Avenue.
- Other things to do:
 - i. Georgetown – shops, restaurants, nightlife, waterfront just a short cab ride away!
 - ii. Metro Center – shops, restaurants, walk to National Mall
 - iii. Chinatown – shops, restaurants, museums, nightlife just a short cab ride or walk from hotel!
 - iv. Dupont Circle – shops, restaurants, nightlife just a short cab ride away
 - v. Double Decker, Trolley, Walking, Segway, Bicycle & Boat Tours
