Subject: Boeing Quality Management System Requirements for Distributors

Dear Boeing Distributor:

Distributors play an important role in ensuring the quality of Boeing products. As part of our continuing drive to improve quality, Boeing will require distributors to possess a Quality Management System certified to AS/EN 9120, "Quality Management Systems – Requirements for Aviation, Space and Defense Distributors," in accordance with D6-82479, "Boeing Quality Management System Requirements for Suppliers." Note: AS/EN/JISQ 9100, "Quality Management Systems – Requirements for Aviation, Space and Defense Operations," certification is an acceptable alternative to AS/EN 9120 certification.

Distributors must be certified by an accredited Certification Body (CB) listed in the International Aerospace Quality Group (IAQG) Online Aerospace Supplier Information System (OASIS) database to continue doing business with The Boeing Company, and shall be required to have the appropriate certified QMS by June 30, 2014. After this date and when required for procurement with distributors, Boeing will contractually require a Quality Management System certified to AS/EN/JISQ 9100 or AS/EN 9120.

Additionally, distributors that perform or outsource manufacturing or fabrication processes that affect or could affect product characteristics or conformity and/or perform value added services, must be certified to AS/EN/JISQ 9100. AS/EN/JISQ 9100 certification for these situations is a current requirement.

Quality Management System requirements will be imposed via purchase contract language which will impose D6-82479, "Boeing Quality Management System Requirements for Suppliers,"

To ensure certification, we encourage our distributors to initiate dialog with an accredited Certification Body listed in the IAQG OASIS database (http://www.iaqq.sae.org/servlets/index?PORTAL_CODE=IAQG) and begin planning for successful deployment and certification.
