
Accreditation Program

- 307 facilities accredited to ASA-100
- Approx. 14% of companies have more than one facility accredited to ASA-100.
 - Companies are strategically opening facilities in various regions around the world.
 - Competing with local, regionally-based, companies within that region's market.
- Although small in comparison to the number of ASA-100 companies in the U.S., there has been steady growth in the U.K., Middle East, and Asia.
 - Approx. 10% of ASA-100 facilities are outside of the U.S.

Accreditation Program

- ASA-100 continues to have the highest percentage of companies on the FAA AC 00-56A Database (43%)
 - This percentage has remained steady.
 - In general, the total number of companies on the database continues to increase. Current count is over 690.



Accreditation Program

- The program has accredited its first company in Jordan, and a second company in China will likely be added before the end of 2013.
- ASA is seeing a small, but consistent, increase in brokers seeking accreditation.
 - A broker is still required to meet all of the requirements of the Standard.
 - ASA continues to refer to definitions listed in the ASA-100 Standard and FAA AC 00-56A to address these situations.
Ex. definition of a distributor
- More joint ASA-100 & ISO/AS audits have been conducted and we are pressing forward.
