ASA has established a COVID-19 resource page on its <u>website</u> (<u>including new information on SBA Loans</u>) and will be sharing information through LinkedIn. Country and/or Region centric emails will be sent to members about government relief. This is beneficial for sharing information about government resources for recovery.

Every company and all their workers need to contact their government representatives. It is important that any relief packages cover all companies in the aviation supply chain. We do need the air carriers to be operating but this is a unique situation and the government needs to provide assistance to all.
